- All activities under this contract shall conform to the most current published ANSI A300 standards for pruning and tree support systems.
 - All activities performed under this contract shall conform to the most current published ANSI Z133.1 standards for safe arboricultural operations.
 - Contractor shall provide, at contractor's expense, all tools and equipment necessary to perform the work to the Town's specifications. Contractor is responsible for bringing equipment suitable to meet the demands of the job. Bidders shall submit a list of their available equipment at the time of the submission of their bid for review by the Town to determine whether the equipment available to the bidder is sufficient to complete the work needed by the Town for all circumstances.
 - Contractor will schedule and perform requested tree service work within a time period specified by the ordering department.
 - The Contractor must provide emergency work within three (3) hours of notification by the department. An emergency is defined by the Town on a case by case basis as a situation that could jeopardize public safety.
 - Contractor must notify the Requesting Department the day after completion of work to inspect the work and for work ticket to be signed.
 - When a starting date has been determined by the ordering department, the contractor shall be on the job site on that day and ready to perform work.
 - Town will order services from the lowest price responsible vendor in the first instance. The contractor may be provided with a project timeframe (start date/end date) under which the tree trimming work must be performed. If the work cannot be completed within the established timeframe, the contractor needs to decline the work when it is offered. The Town reserves the right to then call on the next lowest responsible bidder.
 - All work at the site shall be performed during regular hours. Work performed after regular hours must have prior approval of the requesting department. Work performed after regular hours on weekends or legal holidays, shall be performed at the regular hourly rate unless it meets the overtime criteria. Overtime may be paid for work completed under Section 3 (Time and Materials) above. The Town will not pay overtime for work completed under Sections 1 or 2 above as payment for work pursuant to those sections is on a unit price basis.
 - With regard to work assigned under Section 5 above only. Overtime shall be paid only for work that meets BOTH criteria and shall not exceed 150% of the single hourly labor rate:
 - Requested and pre-approved by the requesting department
 - when working continuously the 1st 8 hours are paid at straight time and anytime after that is paid at the overtime rate. Overtime rate shall be 1.5 X straight time.
 - Contractor shall employ at least one employee who holds an ISA (international society of arboriculture) certification, and contractor shall ensure that ISA certification is maintained throughout the contract period. All work shall be performed or supervised by an ISA Certified Arborist or equal certification. Copy of certification must be submitted with the bid. While not a requirement of this bid, it is preferred that bidders have the following certifications for the purpose of trimming trees around overhead utility lines:
 - EHAP Electrical Hazard Awareness Program
 - TRAQ Tree Assessment Risk Qualification
 - All wood waste and/or nonhazardous debris produced under this contract shall be removed from the job site by the contractor the same day it is produced.
 - Bid will be valid for 1 year from date of award with the option to extend for 2 additional one year periods with the same conditions.
 - An award pursuant to this bid provides no guarantee of work. Contractors acknowledge that the Town may make multiple awards to multiple vendors.
 - Contractors acknowledge that the prices submitted to this bid apply to all tree pruning and removal services needed by the Town, regardless of the condition or location of the trees.
- p. Prevailing Wages** - Any labor related to the services to be performed as described in this document is subject to the payment of prevailing wages pursuant to the New York Labor Law and the federal Davis-Bacon Act. Responding firms will be required to pay all workers labor prevailing wages in accordance with the terms of this bid and the Prevailing Wage Schedule (PRC No. 2016011954) and Wage Determination attached to this bid document (whichever is higher). The above-referenced listings of rates are subject to change by the New York State Department of Labor and the United States Department of Labor throughout the term of this bid. The successful bidder or bidders shall be responsible for paying the then-current prevailing wage rate notwithstanding the above listing.
- q. Federal Terms and Conditions** - Bidders are hereby advised that certain of the services requested in this bid document may be funded by federal and state sources. Bidders should read the term and conditions of this bid carefully, in particular Sections 80 through 82 of the General Conditions below, to assure compliance with state and federal requirements.
